Ethics or moral philosophy is a branch of philosophy that involves systematizing, defending, and recommending concepts of right and wrong conduct. The term ethics (or Moral Philosophy) is concerned with questions of how people ought to act, and the search for a definition of right conduct (identified as the one causing Virtue). Ethics (Virtue ethics) is a broad term for theories that emphasize the role of character and virtue in moral philosophy rather than either doing one's duty or Ethical Theory and Moral Practice.
